

Yorke Peninsula Council - 8.2 Notice of Motion: Mining on Yorke Peninsula
13th February 2019

Moved: Cr Roger Johns Seconded: Cr Leanne O'Brien

That Council:

1. Calls on the State Government to:
 - (a) Recognise, protect and enhance the productivity and long term economic viability of our district's agriculture and tourism industries while providing for social and physical well-being of the community; and
 - (b) Ensure that future development does not detract from the "Agriculturally rich and naturally beautiful" character of the district: and
 - (c) Otherwise ensure that the special "agriculturally rich and naturally beautiful" character of the district is preserved for future generations; and
 - (d) Conduct an independent review into land access provisions of the Mining Bill with an aim to develop legislation that provides strong, long-term protection for our agriculture and tourism as well as the social and physical well-being of Yorke Peninsula communities.

2. Calls on the Mayor to advise the Premier, Steven Marshall of Council's resolution, with copies to;
 - (a) The Minister for Mining and Energy, Hon Dan van Holst Pellekaan
 - (b) The Minister for Primary Industries and Regional Development, Hon Tim Whetstone,
 - (c) The Minister for Tourism, Trade and Investment, Hon David Ridgway,
 - (d) The Member for Narungga, Fraser Ellis, and that they be endorsed by his Government.
